



# 14U Individual State Championships

**Sunday, February 24, 2019**

- Location:** Nashua South High School, 36 Riverside Street, Nashua, NH
- Who:** Open to **NHWAY** wrestlers ages 14 and under who are **NH residents**. **NHWAY membership is required for all participants\***
- Equipment:** Headgear required (and head covering for long hair)
- Cost:** \$20 registration fee per wrestler, \$5 spectator for age 11 & up, \$2 for children
- Registration:** Online registration and payment. **Registration closes 8:00 pm, Feb 19, 2019.**

- Coaches:** Coaches **must** complete the Abuse Prevention System (APS) training in order to be matside. Coaches will check-in to receive coaches' bands.

- Format:** Double-elimination 8- or 16-man brackets for weight classes with 6 or more wrestlers, round-robin brackets for classes with 5 or fewer wrestlers.
- Weight & Ages:** All wrestlers **MUST** weigh-in at or below the NHWAY weight class plus 1 lb. If wrestler misses weight, he/she can move up to the next weight class after paying a **\$10 rebracketing fee at the scale (no exceptions)**. Coaches may move weight classes for registered wrestlers by e-mailing [gary@nhway.org](mailto:gary@nhway.org) up until registration closes. Competition divisions and weight classes are:

**12U** – Birth yr 2006-07: 58, 63, 69, 73, 77, 81, 86, 91, 97, 103, 111, 123, 138, 154, 176 & 202  
**14U** – Birth yr 2004-05: 74, 81, 88, 94, 100, 106, 112, 118, 124, 130, 136, 143, 154, 169, 188, 215 & 260
- Awards:** Medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Top 4 placers **born before Aug 31, 2010** qualify to compete in the Youth New England Wrestling Championships at St. Anselm's College, March 9-10, 2019.

### Additional Information

#### WEIGH-INS:

Weigh-ins will open at 7:00 am. Any wrestler in the tournament may weigh-in during the first weigh-in time however the 1<sup>st</sup> session age divisions (6U, 8U, 10U) will have priority. Weigh-ins will close promptly at posted times.

Weight classes will have a 1 lb allowance to account for differences in scales. This means that wrestlers can weigh a 1 lb over the published weight on the day of the tournament and still wrestle in that class (e.g. wrestlers in the 37 lb class can weigh up to 38 lbs).

Wrestlers must select a weight class at the time of registration but may alter their selection up until the time registration closes (8:00 pm, Feb 19, 2019). After registration closes, there is a **mandatory \$10 rebracketing fee** if a wrestler needs to be moved to another weight class for **any reason** (missing weight, came in light enough to go down a bracket, etc.). Please be sure parents are aware of this. **Fee must be paid at the scale in order to be in the tournament (no exceptions)**. Bracket change requests should be e-mailed to aaron@nhway.org and gary@nhway.org with "**States Bracket Change**" in the subject line. Include the wrestler's name, club, original weight class and new weight class. You will receive a confirmation e-mail when change is complete.

#### CHALLENGES:

Wrestlers must be New Hampshire residents to participate in NHWAY State Championships. They also must be registered in the proper age bracket. If a team or an individual believes a wrestler is not a New Hampshire resident or is too old for the division in which the wrestler is competing, a challenge can be issued. The process for challenges is as follows.

- The challenger must present \$50 to the NHWAY tournament director and clearly state the nature of the challenge and wrestler involved.
- The wrestler/club that is challenged will have to prove age or residency within 24 hours. Examples of acceptable proof: wrestler's birth certificate, copy of current report card, copy of current utility bill with parent name clearly linked to wrestler name, etc.
- If the challenged wrestler is unable to produce proof of age/residency within 24 hours to NHWAY, the wrestler's results will be nullified and all other wrestler's in bracket will be elevated by 1 finishing position and the challenger will be refunded the \$50 fee.
- If the challenged wrestler provides acceptable proof of age/residency within 24 hours, the tournament results will be certified **and NHWAY will keep the \$50 challenge fee**.

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
